Frequently Asked Questions**

How do students sign up?

Pam White, a veteran Bozeman home school mom, will be coordinating the M-BAR-T program for the home school community. Contact her at 587-6163 or e-mail her at pwhite@page16.com if you have questions about the program and its qualification requirements.

1. Send a copy of your student(s) Spring 2009 Iowa Test of Basic Skills (ITBS) results (Complete Composite National Stanine (NS) score of 7 or above) to verify student qualification to:

2. Pam will confirm qualification and include your student's name on the M-BAR-T program qualified student list and then will notify you of your student's qualification.
3. Your student(s) will then take his/her completed M-BAR-T application form and a one-time \$15.00 processing fee per student to the Season Pass Office at Moonlight Basin (located at the Madison Village Base Area) on his/her first day of skiing to receive their season pass. Applications are available online at www.moonlightbasin.com.

We did not test with the Gallatin Valley Home Educators, can we still participate in M-BAR-T?

Yes! New for 2009-10, Spring ITBS tests administered to a home school student by a "qualified tester" in a home setting will now be accepted for qualification consideration.

Can we go to the Season Pass Office directly and bring our test scores with us?

No, the Season Pass Office at Moonlight Basin has an ongoing list of eligible students provided by Pam White. Please send your test scores to Pam to verify eligibility prior to arriving at Moonlight Basin.

Where can we rent equipment?

Daily rental equipment is also available for M-BAR-T pass holders for only \$15 at the MoonRide Rental Shop at the Madison Village Base Area. All you need to do is present your active M-BAR-T pass.

Can home school students ski on a weekday as their "PE Day"?

Yes, the season pass can be used for PE days. In addition, the pass can be used Saturday and Sunday, as well as school holidays (Christmas break, spring break, etc.).

Will season passes be deactivated on January 30, 2010 for home school students as noted on the season pass application?

No, the home school ski pass will not be deactivated on January 30th. The Spring 2009 Iowa Test of Basic Skills (ITBS) is the single grading tool used to qualify students for the entire 09-10 ski season. The application form is the universal form for all students in public, private, and home school programs.

My student did not take the Iowa Test of Basic Skills (ITBS) this spring, how can we qualify?

The ITBS is the only way to verify eligibility for the M-BAR-T program at this time.
